

Z83 Application Form – Free Download Guide

SA Easy resource for South African government job applications

The Z83 is the official application form for most Public Service jobs in South Africa. You must use the correct version or your application can be rejected.

IMPORTANT: Use only the current form

The form must say Effective 01 January 2021 (or the current version published by DPSA). Do not use old forms from WhatsApp groups or outdated websites.

Where to download the official Z83 (free)

1. Department of Public Service and Administration (DPSA)

Website: <https://www.dpsa.gov.za>

- Look under documents / forms / vacancies for Application for Employment (Z83).

2. Any Public Service department reception (printed copies are free)

3. Official vacancy pages linked from www.gov.za and departmental sites

What to submit with the Z83

- Fully completed, signed and dated Z83 (all sections)
- A detailed CV
- Follow the advert: many departments only ask for certified copies if you are shortlisted
- Submit before the closing date and time through the channel in the advert only

Quick checklist before you send

- Correct / latest Z83 version
- Exact post title and reference number from the advert
- All sections completed
- Signed and dated
- CV attached if required
- Official email, portal or address only — never pay to apply
